



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE M.A. INTERNATIONAL SOCIAL SCIENCES

(Development Studies)

The Scholarship Program of Friedensau Adventist University offers a limited number of prospective students the opportunity to receive a scholarship to pursue a Master's degree in International Social Science (Development Studies). The scholarship will be used to reduce the tuition fee. The amount granted is € 5000 and will be paid at the beginning of the MA program. The scholarship holder is entitled to apply for any other available scholarships during the course of study.

Aims of the Scholarship

The scholarship program aims to enable highly skilled and motivated students (mainly but not only from low and lower middle income countries) a place on the MA International Social Sciences program. Furthermore, the scholarships help to maintain and increase the diversity of the student body in this program.

Eligibility

To apply for this scholarship, prospective students must:

- Be admitted to the M.A. International Social Science at Friedensau Adventist University
- Have proven academic skills with a record of excellence and achievement
- Be able to demonstrate that they are highly motivated to study and reflect on issues related to the field of development and humanitarian aid

Application instructions

The application for the scholarship is integrated into the application for admission to the M.A. program; there is no separate procedure for the scholarship. Prospective students can apply for the Scholarship by indicating during the application for admission that they wish to apply for the ISS scholarship.

In addition to the documents necessary for admission to the Master program, applicants have to submit a motivation letter and to upload a CV (both as PDF files).

Selection Process

A scholarship committee at the University selects the scholarship holders according to the above mentioned aims. The committee consists of the Dean of the School of Social Science, the Head of the Master Program, and one member assigned by the Faculty of the School of Social Science. In the process of selection, prospective scholarship holders might be asked for a short interview via internet.

Deadline for admission: 30 April 2019 (course starts in October 2019)
